

CONSERVATORY PLACEMENT ACTIVITY GUIDELINES

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC CONSERVATORY THE GARN FAMILY JAZZ STUDIES PROGRAM (Grades 7-12) In-Person Placement Activity

After your online application is processed, you will be invited to participate in an in-person placement activity, which will consist of the following:

High School Placement Activity

- All Instrumentalists (except drum set) should be prepared to demonstrate the following:
 - All 12 major scales. Demonstration of minor and/or Jazz scales is encouraged, but not required.
 - Sight reading.

Middle School Placement Activity

- All Instrumentalists (except drum set) should be prepared to demonstrate the following:
 - Major scales up to four sharps and flats.
 - Sight reading.

All Grades

- **Woodwind, Brass, Piano, Guitar, and Bass:**
 - Prepared jazz piece from one of the following: *Greg Fishman Jazz Etudes Vol. 3*, *Lennie Niehaus*, or *Jim Snidero Jazz Conception Series*.
 - Improvisation on Bb flat concert blues, or you may choose a Jazz standard from the list linked [HERE](#).
- **Bass (additional demonstration):**
 - Demonstrate swing/walking bass and Latin style bass.
 - Upright bass strongly encouraged.

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- **Drum Set (Middle School):**

- Perform a swing groove at a slow, medium, and fast tempo using sticks.
- Perform a swing groove at a slow, medium, and fast tempo using brushes.
- Perform the shuffle rhythm, first with no accent, then with an accent or backbeat on 2 and 4.
- Perform a 12-bar blues at a medium to fast tempo trading (alternating) choruses between the straight time and soloing for 6 choruses.

- **Drum Set (High School):**

- Perform a swing groove at a slow, medium, and fast tempo using sticks.
- Perform a swing groove at a slow, medium, and fast tempo using brushes.
- Perform the shuffle rhythm, first with no accent, then with an accent or backbeat on 2 and 4.
- Perform a 12-bar blues at a medium to fast tempo trading (alternating) choruses between the straight time and soloing for 6 choruses.
- Perform the following grooves: New Orleans (Second Line) and 6/8 Afro Cuban.
- Sight reading.
