



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

SUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS - WILLIAMS ACT

This public hearing notice is issued pursuant to California Education Code § 60119

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Governing Board of Orange County School of the Arts will hold a Public Hearing to receive public comment and to make the required determination as to whether each pupil at Orange County School of the Arts has sufficient standards-aligned textbooks and instructional materials in accordance with the Williams legislation and Education Code § 60119.

MEETING DETAILS:

The Public Hearing will take place during the regularly scheduled Board meeting on Wednesday, November 19, 2025, beginning at 5:00 pm at:

At such time the testimony of all interested persons will be heard during the Public Hearing portion of the meeting. Speakers will be given a maximum of three (3) minutes each to address the Board.

The purpose of this hearing is to comply with the State's annual requirement that all local governing boards review and publicly confirm the adequacy of instructional materials for students. Specifically, the Governing Board must determine whether every student in grades 7–12 has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials—both for classroom and home use—that are aligned with the California State Board of Education's content standards and consistent with the curriculum frameworks in the following subject areas:

- English Language Arts (including English Language Development)
- Mathematics
- Science
- History/Social Science

In addition, the Board will determine whether all students enrolled in World Language and Health courses have sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, and whether adequate laboratory science equipment is available for all science laboratory classes offered in grades 9–12.
