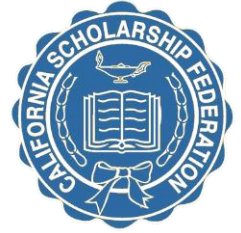


## California Scholarship Federation (CSF) Frequently Asked Questions



### **What is CSF?**

*Answer: The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) is an academic honors society that recognizes the academic achievement of students in the state of California.*

### **How can I apply to join CSF/ What are the requirements?**

*Answer: You can apply for CSF through the digital application linked on Art Attack, the Aeries communications portal, and the 'CSF Potential Members' google classroom (code qw5xv4y). The requirements to join CSF can be viewed in the digital application.*

### **What responsibilities do I have as a CSF member?**

*Answer: As a CSF member, it is your responsibility to complete a certain amount of community service events per semester and attend monthly meetings. CSF members must earn 7 points a semester. Points are earned through community service events.*

### **What do I do in CSF?**

*Answer: In CSF, you will participate in community service events and attend monthly meetings.*

### **What are the benefits to joining CSF?**

*Answer: CSF offers college scholarships to recognized members\*. CSF also enables you to help your community through service events.*

### **When are CSF applications released?**

*Answer: The date for the release of applications varies each year, however they are typically released early September for Fall semester membership, and late January for Spring semester membership.*

### **How long is one term of membership?**

*Answer: CSF Membership renews each semester. Even if you are a member during the Fall semester, you **MUST** reapply for the Spring semester if you wish to continue to be a member of CSF.*

### **How is CSF different from NHS?**

- CSF: must renew membership each semester.
- NHS: lifelong membership
- CSF and NHS are both academic honors societies which vary only slightly; CSF being exclusive to the state of California and NHS being offered nationwide.

*\*Please note, CSF members are not guaranteed a CSF college scholarship. CSF members must apply for the CSF scholarships, offered to them their senior year of high school.*
