Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are the requirements for my senior portrait to be included in the yearbook?

A: Your senior portrait must:

- Be saved as a JPEG file.
- Have a resolution of at least 300 dpi.
- Meet the size requirement of 5 megabytes or less.
- Be an actual photo of you. No drawings or other artistic representations.
- Be in vertical or “portrait” format. Horizontal photos will result in cropping, which could change the image significantly.
- Abide by the 2026-2027 Student/Parent Handbook Guidelines regarding dress code, etc.
- NOTE: Your baby photo must meet the same requirements listed above.

Q: How can I submit my senior portrait, quote, and baby photo to the yearbook staff?

A: You MUST submit ALL required items by **Monday, January 11, 2027** via the GOOGLE FORM found at www.ocsarts.net/SeniorYearbookInfo.

Q: What is the deadline for submitting my senior portrait, quote, and baby photo?

A: You MUST submit all three via the GOOGLE FORM (www.ocsarts.net/SeniorYearbookInfo) by **Monday, January 11, 2027** to ensure inclusion in the yearbook. If we do not receive your senior portrait by this deadline, we will use your student ID photo in the yearbook. No late submissions will be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Q: How can I purchase a yearbook?

A: All yearbooks are sold online via www.MySchoolBucks.com.

There are two options:

1. As part of one of two Senior Package options (deadline to purchase a Senior Package is **Monday, October 5, 2026**):
 - Senior Package A – yearbook, cap and gown, grad night admission, panoramic photo, senior t-shirt, and class ring.
 - Senior Package B – yearbook, cap and gown, grad night admission, panoramic photo, and senior t-shirt.
2. Individual yearbook purchase.

Q: How can I purchase a senior ad?

A: Please see the [separate one-sheet](#) regarding senior ads.

Q: What is the deadline for submitting my senior ad?

A: You must submit your senior ad by **Friday, January 11, 2026**.

Senior Quotes Policy

When picking a quote, keep in mind that it will be published to an audience of students in grades 7-12, parents of students, as well as faculty and administration, and should be appropriate to read aloud in a school environment. This quote allows you to leave your final mark on your high school experience and to create a lasting memory that people will look back on. We urge you to choose a quote that holds great meaning to you.

All quotes must follow rules and guidelines given in the OCSA 2026-2027 Student/Parent Handbook, as well as the guidelines given below. Quotes that do not follow this policy will be excluded from publication in the 2026-2027 Dreamscape Yearbook. You have been given the opportunity to submit a first choice and second choice quote. There will not be a third opportunity.

- Submitted quotes may not exceed the character limit of 100, including quotation marks and the name of the person/film/song/book/play/character quoted.
- Submission may not contain an inappropriate or hidden acronym.
- Submission may not contain mention of, or reference to, any personal social media handles.
- Submission may not contain URL links or timestamps which lead to media outside of the yearbook, including but not limited to documents, videos, movies, shows, or websites.
- Submission may not be cited to a source from which it does not originate.
- Submission may not mention, reference, or originate from any student or staff from the OCSA community without explicit permission from the mentioned person.
- Submission may not be taken from an inappropriate source, or a source focusing on inappropriate topics, situations, or otherwise, regardless of the content of the submission.
- Submission may not contain profanity, derogatory, obscene, offensive, or inappropriate language.
- Submission may not contain mention of, or reference to, drugs, cigarettes, alcohol, sex, sexual innuendoes, gangs, gang-affiliated phrases/words/topics, or violence.
- Submission may not promote sexist, racist, homophobic, xenophobic, ableist, or classist thought/ideology.
- Submission may not contain harassments or language which disparages any religion, group, ethnicity, sexuality, gender, person, being, or physical/mental ability.
- Submission may not contain any negative targeting or bullying of any person.
- Submission may not contain double meanings or subtext with malicious intent.
- Submission may not contain mention of, or reference to, inflammatory topics or triggering content, pursuant to the discretion of the yearbook staff, editors, adviser, or administration.
- Submission may not contain content that may be misconstrued as inappropriate, rude, negative, offensive, or derogatory, pursuant to the discretion of the yearbook staff, editors, adviser, or administration.

Quotes must be submitted in the format: "Quote." -Source

Example: "Let us make our future now, and let us make our dreams tomorrow's reality." -Malala Yousafzai

Any quote that does not follow the given guidelines, pursuant to the discretion of the yearbook staff, editors, adviser, or administration, risks not being published in the yearbook. Any overtly problematic quotes may result in disciplinary action from administration. The yearbook staff, editors, and adviser are not required to return any quote for revision. The yearbook staff, editors, and adviser are not required to notify any student of any quote that has not been accepted. The yearbook staff, editors, and adviser are not required to notify any student of which quote, their first or second choice, if either, is accepted.
